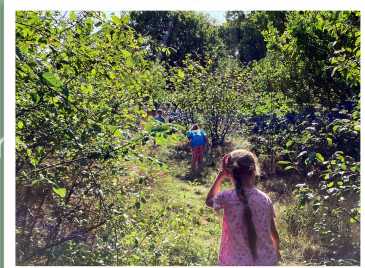

Active Learning:

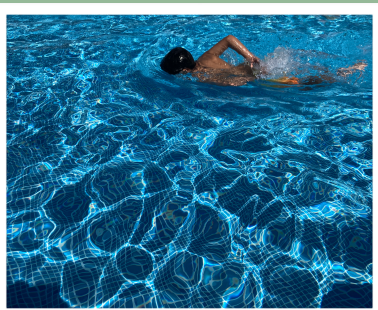
